UNIFORM OUTLINE

To help foster a school culture of unity, discipline, and excellence all students will wear uniforms. Uniforms must be worn at all times during the school day and on field trips unless instructed otherwise. The design of our uniform policy is simple and professional.

All uniform components are to be purchased through our uniform provider, Dennis Uniforms. The only exceptions are jeans, spirit day shirts, or accessories such as bows, socks, belts, etc.

Anthem Uniforms fall into four different categories: Chapel, Daily, P.E., and Spirit as defined below.

Chapel Uniform: Formal uniform required for chapel and special occasions (2-3x a month), acceptable as daily uniform

<u>Daily Uniform</u>: Standard uniform required (3x a week)

Spirit Days: Casual day designed to promote school spirit

<u>Chapel Uniform:</u> Plaid Jumper with White Peter Pan Blouse, shorts/bloomers underneath, neutral shoe, gray cardigan (optional)

<u>Daily Uniform</u>: Chapel Uniform OR Green or White Polo with Khaki skort, or Green Polo Dress, neutral shoe

<u>P.E. Days</u>: Green Athletic Shorts or Sweatpants with Gray Anthem P.E. t-shirt and sweatshirt, tennis shoes

Spirit Days: Any school sponsored or approved t-shirt or sweatshirt with jeans

GIRLS 4TH-8TH

<u>Chapel Uniform</u>: Plaid Pleated Skirt with White Blouse, shorts/bloomers underneath, neutral shoe, gray cardigan (optional)

<u>Daily Uniform</u>: Chapel Uniform OR Green or White Polo with Khaki skirt, or Green Polo Dress, neutral shoe

P.E. Days: Green Athletic Shorts with Gray Anthem P.E. t-shirt, tennis shoes **Spirit Days:** Any school sponsored or approved t-shirt or sweatshirt with jeans

BOYS K-8TH

<u>Chapel Uniform</u>: Khaki Pants with black or brown belt, White Oxford Shirt, neutral shoe, gray cardigan (optional)

<u>Daily Uniform</u>: Chapel Uniform OR Green or White Polo with Khaki shorts or pants, neutral shoe

<u>P.E. Days</u>: Green Athletic Shorts with Gray Anthem P.E. t-shirt, tennis shoes <u>Spirit Days:</u> Any school sponsored or approved t-shirt or sweatshirt with jeans

^{*}Boys 4-8th REQUIRE the Plaid Tie on Chapel day.

^{*}Boys K-3rd should NOT wear the tie yet.

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

Uniforms are to be worn at all times during the school day and on field trips unless special instructions are sent home. **Please label all uniform items** including outerwear, bags, hats, gloves, etc. with your child's first and last name.

Essentials of our dress code are as follows:

- Hair must be of a natural color, and must be cut or worn out of one's face
- **Jewelry/Accessories:** Headbands and bows may only be green, white, navy, grey, or matching our plaid. Earrings are limited to one per ear and no additional piercings, or visible tattoos. A student wearing excessive or distracting jewelry or accessories may be asked to remove it.
- **Skirts/Jumpers:** Alteration and hem length for skirts, shorts and jumpers should be within approximately 2" from top of the knee
- Shirts may be either long or short sleeve (unless specifically stated) and must always be tucked in
- Pants and shorts must be Dennis Uniform unless otherwise permitted
- Belts: Brown or black belt must be worn with pants and shorts
- Socks should be white, black, grey, or navy with no logos
- **Shoes:** Shoes should be of majority neutral color (white, black, brown, forest green, gray, or navy) and not include light-up, sparkle, or wheels. Shoes must be closed-toe and functional for the school day.
- **Tights or leggings** must be white, grey, or navy and may be worn under skirts or jumpers (sweatpants are not permitted under skirts or jumpers.) For PE only, athletic leggings may be worn if they do not have Dennis Uniform sweatpants.
- Outerwear: Inside the building students should only wear the embroidered green or grey Anthem sweaters, or all-weather jacket from our uniform supplier. Outside of the building, students may wear any outerwear of their choice. Please provide your children with sufficient and effective outerwear to be comfortable playing outdoors even in the coldest months. Hats, beanies, hoods, head coverings of any kind are not to be worn in the building, but are permissible outside.
- **Smart watches:** Students are not permitted to bring any devices, including cell phones, computers, tablets, Kindles, bluetooth speakers, video games, or smart watches onto school property. Logic students are permitted to have a digital screen watch with no messaging or photo capabilities.
- Gender: Students must dress according to their biological gender (girls are permitted to wear pants and shorts).

If an infraction to the uniform policy occurs, actions should result in a notice to parents, and may require student's dress code to be resolved before returning to class. See Student Handbook for more information.
